North Somerset Arts is planning a sculpture trail the 1st weekend in July 2010.

- The sculptures have to be suitable for outside and sustain the weather and nights.
- All work submitted must be the original work of the exhibitor and should not be the work of more than one person (excluding production processes).

- Arrangements will be made for all exhibitors to come and view the venue prior to the Sculpture Trail and discuss final points.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRY FORMS

- Completed Entry forms must be returned to NSA by 7th May 2010
- There is a one off non refundable fee of £15 per artist, payable with the entry form. This will help to cover admin and advertising costs and entry on the website.
- Entry fee of £15 to be paid to North Somerset Arts, and sent to 103 Beach Rd, Sand bay BS22 9UG by deadline with the form.

DELIVERY OF WORKS

- Works must be delivered on Wednesday 30th June 2010 between 10am and 5pm (alternative arrangements may be made on request).
- Any packaging/ covering material used in transit must be removed before the works are installed and no packaging can be stored.
- Each work must be clearly labelled with name and address of artist, medium, title of work, price or NFS. Indicate also if commissions can be undertaken.
- An artist statement will also be useful for display.

Arrangement and display of works will be overseen by the organizers but in partnership with the artists. Every effort will be made to meet the wishes of the exhibitors, but the organizers will have the final say. Please note that the organizers do not have any plinths or pedestals. This will have to be provided by the exhibitors if need be. NSA will work with the artists to create the best display possible.

PRIVATE VIEWING

A private viewing will take place on Friday 2nd July from 5pm onwards. If you wish to invite guests please let us have their names and addresses with your entry form. Wine and nibbles will be provided.

COLLECTION OF EXHIBITED WORKS

The exhibitors must arrange for collection of exhibited works from Backwell Hill Cottage by Wednesday 7th July. Any work not collected by that date will be removed by the organizers and can be collected by arrangements.

INSURANCE

North Somerset Arts will take a Public Liability Insurance, but it will be the responsibility of each exhibitor to insure their work. NSA will not be liable for any loss however incurred.

CATALOGUE

An exhibition Catalogue will be produced which will include prices of exhibits for sale. Prices and titles of sculptures may not be altered once the works have been delivered to Backwell Hill Cottage.

DETAILS OF WORK(S) SUBMITTED

- For large sculptures, a maximum of 6 per artist will be accepted.
- For smaller sculptures, 6 will be on display (and others stored if necessary)
- For small garden ceramics discussion will take place with the respective exhibitors as to the number of items to be displayed and/ or stored.
